Ps. 18 is actually found twice in the Bible. It is found in the _____ book of Israel, in II Sam. 22, and in the _____ of Israel, here in Ps. 18. You may have a _____ in your Bible at the beginning of Ps. 18 which reads as follows: *“To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David, the servant of the LORD, who spake unto the LORD the words of this song in the day that the LORD delivered him from the hand of all his enemies, and from the hand of Saul.”*

Note that David describes himself as “the _____ of the Lord.”

The word “_____” occurs twice; the word “_____” once. All three are the same Hebrew word. This is the only verse in the Bible that uses the English word “paw.”
